

NY City: Food Delivery Assistance

Description of Program and Relief

New York City will be delivering meals to qualifying residents who cannot leave their homes to get food and cannot afford food delivery. Individuals and families who qualify may place a food delivery order once every two days. Each order will contain meals for two days per person (4 meals per person in the household, but no household will receive more than 8 meals per delivery).

Orders placed before 11:00 A.M. will be delivered within two days of the order date. Orders placed after 11:00 A.M. will be delivered within three days of the order date.

Government or Lead Agency

New York City; the lead agency is not available at this time.

Eligibility Requirements/Restrictions

Individuals and families must meet all of the following criteria:

- No members of the household can go out and get food because they are at increased medical risk or homebound;
- No neighbors or family members can go out and get food for the household;
- The household does not receive meal assistance from other providers (*e.g.* Meals on Wheels or God's Love We Deliver); and
- The household is unable to afford meal delivery or grocery delivery.

If a household does not meet all of the above requirements, individuals and families can still access their [local food pantries](#).
